From the heart of the pain left behind by the Gaza war, a story of hope was born.. one that carries the name Maha Sharab. A ten year old girl who lost her leg as a result of shelling, Maha suddenly found herself facing a harsh reality she had never imagined.



At the beginning, Maha went through a difficult phase marked by physical disability and deep psychological and emotional pain. Her eyes were filled with questions, her steps came to a halt, and her dreams of play ran only through her imagination. Yet, in the midst of this darkness, a glimmer of hope appeared.



With determination and continuous support, Maha moved from a stage of helplessness to one of hope. She learned how to regain her balance, how to move again, and how to laugh without fear. Today, Maha has returned to being the child she should be—playing, laughing, and dreaming.



Her journey began with the Khan Younis Rehabilitation Team at Juzoor. The road was challenging, marked by long therapy sessions and repeated trials, but with continuous support, tears slowly turned into smiles. Beyond physical rehabilitation, the team helped rebuild Maha's confidence and belief in herself.



Maha's story is not just one of recovery; it is a message that willpower is stronger than war, and that true rehabilitation begins in the heart before the body.
