Al Nasr Clinic: Integrated care where people need it most

Amid continuing health and humanitarian challenges in the Gaza Strip, Juzoor for Health and Social Development continues to provide comprehensive health and social services through Al Nasr Clinic for residents of Al Nasr and surrounding communities. The clinic is a vital access point for primary care, prevention, treatment, rehabilitation, and psychosocial support, with particular attention to women, children, older persons, and people injured by the war.

Maternal, child and nutrition care

The clinic provided antenatal follow-up, ultrasound examinations, family planning, postnatal care, and nutrition screening and follow-up for children, pregnant women, and breastfeeding mothers. During June, 977 children were screened and 188 were identified as needing malnutrition follow-up.



Older persons: follow-up, treatment and support

Older persons benefited from medical consultations, screening, medication, health education, and psychosocial support. Services helped identify new cases of high blood pressure and diabetes, supporting early detection and continued follow-up for chronic conditions.



Care that goes beyond treatment

Al Nasr Clinic combines the response to daily health needs with protection, prevention, and recovery. This integrated model enables patients and their families to access connected services in one place, reducing barriers and strengthening continuity of care.

4,918 nursing and emergency services

Including wound dressings, blood pressure and glucose checks, burns and emergency care, and blood sample collection.

1,949 psychosocial support and health education services

Group and individual sessions for women and older persons, counselling for survivors of violence, and referrals when needed.

4,001 prescriptions dispensed

Supporting patients' access to prescribed medication through medical follow-up within the clinic.

1,943 laboratory tests

Blood, urine, pregnancy, and other tests that support timely medical diagnosis.

Rehabilitation: restoring mobility and independence

The rehabilitation department continued to provide physiotherapy, occupational therapy, and psychosocial and social counselling for children and people injured by the war. It also distributed 187 assistive devices, including wheelchairs, crutches, medical mattresses, and other aids. These services help injured people and amputees regain independence and participate in daily life.
